#### Getting To Jorhat

##### FLIGHTS TO JORHAT

**Delhi (DEL) - Jorhat (JRH):** IndiGo flight 6E 767 departs at 11:30 AM from New Delhi and arrives at Jorhat at 2:00 PM (flight duration approx 2h 30m)

**Kolkata (CCU) - Jorhat (JRH):** IndiGo flight 6E 326 departs at 12:35 PM from Kolkata and arrives at 2:05 PM in Jorhat (direct flight, duration about 1h 30m)

**Mumbai (BOM) - Jorhat (JRH):** No direct flight. Most itineraries are 1-stop (typically via New Delhi)

**Chennai (MAA) - Jorhat (JRH):** No direct flight. Most itineraries are 1-stop (typically via New Delhi)

##### TRAINS

**12067 Jan Shatabdi (GHY - JTTN):** Daily except Sundays (Arrival at approx. 1:30 pm)

**15665 BG Express (GHY - JTTN):** Daily, (Arrival at night)

**15669 Nagaland Exp (GHY - JTTN):** Daily, (Arrival at morning)

**15959 Kamrup Exp Howrah Jn (HWH) - Mariani Jn (MXN):** Sun, Tue, Wed, Thurs, Sat (Arrival at night)

**12424 New Delhi-Dibrugarh Rajdhani Express** runs daily, departing New Delhi at 4:20 PM and arriving at Mariani Jn around 2:33 AM the next day.

**Major stations touched by trains to Jorhat include:** Guwahati, Lumding, Mariani, Dibrugarh, Simaluguri, Harmuti, and Tinsukia.

##### Flights to Dibrugarh (nearest airport to Jorhat):

**Delhi:** Air India flights like AI 2726 departing at 12:30 PM, duration ~3h 25m

**Kolkata:** Multiple airlines operate direct flights.

##### From Dibrugarh to Jorhat travel options:

**Road:** Frequent taxis, private cars, and buses, approximately 3–4 hours drive.

**Train:** Multiple trains from Dibrugarh to Jorhat Mariani station, Nagaland Express 15670, Vivek Express 22504.

##### ROAD

National Highways NH-27/NH-715 link Jorhat with Guwahati, Assam; daily state/private buses and abundant shared vans.

##### Places to visit near Jorhat

Kaziranga National Park, Majuli Island, and Sibsagar are must-visit attractions near Jorhat, showcasing Assam's wildlife, including one-horned rhino, Vaishnavite culture and Sibsagar boasts magnificent Ahom monuments such as Rang Ghar, Talatal Ghar, Kareng Palace, Shiva Dol, Vishnu Dol, Devi Dol, and the royal mausoleum Charai Deo, each reflecting the dynasty's architectural grandeur and historical legacy.

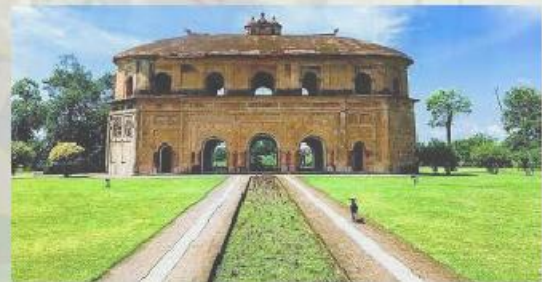

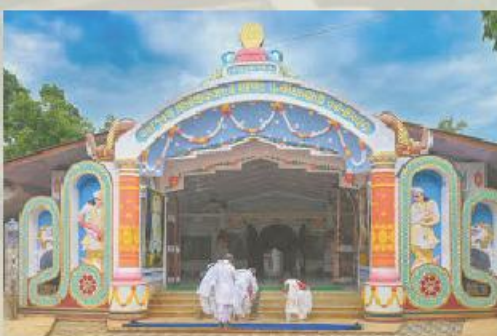
